

FIREARM PROCEDURES



GUN PICKUP, REGISTRATION, AND FEES

For any firearm purchased at our Sportsman auctions, the buyer must complete a ATF Form 4473 (Firearms Transaction Record) and clear a background check before they can receive the firearm. The information on the 4473 form is submitted to the Pennsylvania Instant Check System (PICS). PICS is used by Pennsylvania firearms dealers to verify who can legally buy a firearm. There is a \$15 firearm registration processing fee for first firearm purchased, and \$10 for each additional firearm. You will pay this fee when you pickup your firearm; cash and credit cards accepted. If black powder, no processing fee is paid.

SHIPPING

Hurley Auctions does not ship firearms. No exceptions.

DEALERS & FFL

If you are a dealer and carry an FFL, please submit your current license no later than 2 days prior to auction close by 4:30pm for gun registration exemption.

OUT-OF-STATE PURCHASES

If you are an out-of-state buyer and are interested in a handgun, you must reach out to an FFL dealer and arrange for them to pick up the gun from our office. The FFL dealer will transfer the ownership to you. Buyers are responsible for checking into their state's regulations on purchasing firearms. If you are not legally allowed to purchase a firearm that you won, your money will be refunded to you less a \$100 service fee.
